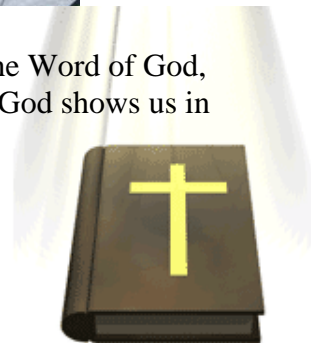


**READ Psalm 119:11** On another piece of paper draw a picture of what this verse says and then memorize the verse.



In the previous part of this lesson we looked at Bible verses that taught us about salvation, the Word of God, and how we can become God’s child. This part will talk about our Christian life and walk. God shows us in His Word how to live our Christian life.

**When you become God’s child a very special event happens to you. Read Galatians 2:20 and find out what Christ does when you become His child.**

Because Christ lives in you He wants you to grow to be more like Him. To do this He grows good behavior in you. We call this the “Fruit of the Spirit.” **Read Galatians 5:19-23** and name the fruit of the Spirit.

The big “S” in the middle of the strawberries will help you remember that this is the Fruit of the **Spirit** which God is building inside you. God wants to see this “fruit” or behavior in your life.

Do you know that God wants you to Pray to Him. **READ Philippians 4:6, 7.** How many things should we pray for? **Fill in the Blanks:** "But \_\_\_\_\_ by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known unto God, ..."

God is saying that in every situation our first reaction should be to pray. We should pray when things are not going great and also when things are great! Some people seem to only pray to God when things do not go right. Since God loves us, we should give thanks to God for everything, good or bad. We should have a very open and real relationship with our God, ...He is our Heavenly Father. He is watching over you...He loves you.

When you trusted Christ, you became a child of God. Reading God's Word is how God speaks to you through the Spirit, Prayer is how you talk to God. God wants you to talk to Him. Praying is really just talking to God. And He listens!!!

We don't always know what the best answer to our prayers should be... but God does. So He (the Spirit) helps us and God answers every prayer we pray...according to His will and with the purpose of producing what is best in our life from an eternal viewpoint. God knows everything...even what will happen tomorrow!

**Romans 8:28** says "... we know that all things work together for good to them that love God, to them who are the called according to his purpose."

God loves you. Remember Jesus Christ died on the cross, and rose the third day so that you could be free from sin. Why not thank Him now for all He has done for you! Pray.
